We are proud to offer the Marvin Baida Mentor Scholarship Award. It was created in May of 2007 for the advancement of young professionals who wish to grow in the promotional product industry.

The scholarship was named after Marvin Baida, a veteran in the promotional product industry, who has mentored hundreds of promotional sales and support people throughout his 40+ years in the industry.

Marvin has been an active member of SAAC for many years and to honor him, SAAC founded this scholarship in his name. The scholarship is designed for newer professionals to learn and as much as they can about our industry through existing education programs. The dollars allotted are designated to pay for that education.

Scholarship Rules and Regulations

1. Nominating firm must be a member in good standing with SAAC.
2. Both distributor and supplier personnel are eligible.
3. Nomination must be submitted on an official SAAC form. Additional sheets may be added.
4. You may submit as many candidates as you wish, however a maximum of two scholarships will be awarded (\$1250 each)
5. You must have less than two years experience in the promotional products industry.
6. You must carry full time status with a supplier or distributor.
7. Must be a full time employee of a SAAC member company
8. Application must be signed by a principle of the company
9. Applications will be judged on the following criteria:
 - Application content
 - Recommendations from superiors
 - Future goals within the promotional merchandise industry
